

VINEA DOMINI



SAUVIGNON

a grape variety cultivated in the Bordeaux district, particularly in the Sauterne region. It has found the ideal growing conditions in Italy. The name Sauvignon derives from “Sauvage” and means “wild plant”. It has very similar characteristics to Lambrusca. Along with Chardonnay, it is the most widespread and famous white grape variety in the world, grown successfully in California, Australia and New Zealand.
